

How to disable the built-in PDF viewer and use another viewer in Google Chrome

1. Open a new tab in Chrome and type “chrome://plugins” into the address bar, then hit enter.
2. This will take you to a screen listing all available plugins. Scroll down to “Chrome PDF Viewer” and select “disable”.
3. Close the tab. Your changes will automatically save.

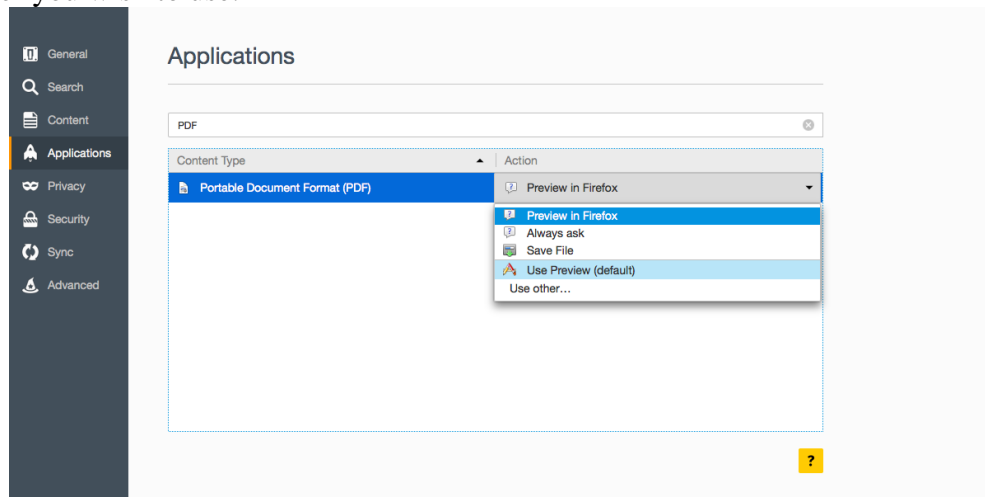
This will change your settings so that your downloaded PDF files will open with your default program (usually Adobe Reader or Preview) instead of with the Chrome PDF Viewer.

How to disable the built-in PDF viewer and use another viewer in Firefox

Third-party PDF viewer plugins are available if you prefer not to use the built-in viewer.

To switch from the built-in PDF viewer to another PDF viewer:

1. Click the menu button ☰ and choose **Options**.
2. Select the **Applications** panel.
3. Find **Portable Document Format (PDF)** in the list and click on it to select it.
4. Click on the drop-down arrow in the **Action** column for the above entry and select the PDF viewer you wish to use.



Note: If you want to view PDF files in Firefox using a plugin, instead of in an external PDF reader application, select **Use *PDF reader name* (in Firefox)**.

5. Close the *about:preferences* page. Any changes you've made will automatically be saved.
